Teamed with project architect Barker Rinker Seacat Architecture of Denver, Library Planning Associates, Inc. worked with library staff and trustees to prepare a building program describing spatial and environmental parameters for a new building of 42,800 square feet. The building is situated on a dramatic site overlooking the Animas River, which runs through the center of Durango. In addition to programming the building, LPA provided plan review services and participated in the architect's public planning forums. The project was recognized by *Library Journal* as the fifth-ranked project in *LJ*'s inaugural New Landmark Libraries:
